## SYNOPSIS

## WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

1. After reading the story we can suggest to the children that they put themselves in the shoes of the protagonists in the story.  
What would you do if you were Imelia?  
What would you do if you were Rudy?  
What would you do if you were Imelia's father?

*For the kids to get into the role, it is helpful they use something symbolic (costumes or a poster with the character's name).*

## MORAL

1. Record a video using the mobile in pairs and talk what the pandemic was like for us, what positive, negative, what we have learned from it and how do you imagine the situation in 1 year's time.
2. See it in class and talk about what stood out.
