SYNOPSIS

An atypical planet, Triton's behaviour is being analysed by astronomers around the world. No one has managed to explain why, but it seems Triton's only goal is to harm everything around it.

The Triton story is a tool that can complement the school's strategy to prevent bullying. The topic, approached from the metaphor, lets each child connect with the reality of bullying and the philosophy behind the unfinished story will invite each child to explore and connect with the right inner resources to handle the challenge.

ISOLATED/DISCONNECTED

1. The group is organized into a ring and each child will go to the centre. We ask each one to tell an anecdote or a story that happened recently but in 2 ways:

- a) The whole group will turn their backs on the kid.
- b) The group will be looking at the kid, nodding and asking questions.

At the end we will ask the kids to share how they felt in both cases. casos.

QUESTIONS ON FEELINGS

- Why did the stars turn off their light?
- What could they do to not lose their light?
- What emotions do Triton's behaviour arouse in you?
- How do you think Triton felt?
- Have you ever felt this way?

FINAL MORAL BY THE GROUP

After each child has written and drawn their ending and the round of questions on feelings, we then seek a conclusion by the group.

What would be the best conclusion we draw from the experience of the session with the whole group?
